## Programs of the YWCA Cass Clay

### Emergency Shelter

The YWCA Emergency Shelter is a secure facility, offering safe, temporary shelter for women and children facing homelessness.

### Shelter Children's Services

Located within the shelter, Shelter Children's Services offers licensed child care, tutoring, and school transportation for children of program participants.

### Education and Employment Program

Offers comprehensive employment and educational readiness training to assist unemployed and underemployed women.

### Shelter Faith Community Nurse

Provides health related resources on-site and addresses clients' immediate health concerns.

### Parent Education Specialist

Offers necessary support by working with parents and children to strengthen the relationship between parent and child.

### Other Emergency Assistance

Food baskets and personal supplies are given to community members not needing housing services, but seeking assistance.

### Transitional and Permanent Supportive Housing

The Transitional Housing and Permanent Supportive Housing programs provide secure, affordable housing and help participants develop the skills needed to achieve independence.



### Racial Justice

The mission of the Racial Justice program is to expand racial understanding, with the ultimate goal of eliminating barriers that foster racism.

### A Child's World

A Child's World, one of nine nationally accredited child care centers in North Dakota, provides high quality childcare for children in an environment that supports all families, regardless of their income, diversity or family structure.

### TechGYRLS

TechGYRLS develops the confidence of girls to use technology and discover links between math and science. Offered to girls in grades four through seven, the program is run in partnership with the NDSU Department of Engineering.
